



# IAM Youth Committee 'doodle competition' RULES & GUIDELINES



There are 5 divisions determined by age group for the Doodle Competition. Each division has its own theme. The divisions are as follows.

- ❖ Kindergarten: Gandhi "The greatest of a nation can be judged by the way its animals are treated."
- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>: Gandhi "A nation's culture resides in the hearts and in the soul of its people."
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> -6<sup>th</sup>: Nehru "Great causes and little men go ill together."  
The theme evolves around just ordinary people making a big difference for a cause, be it small or big. The quote refers to anyone who believes they can fight for a great cause. In short, everyone can make a difference!
- ❖ 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>: Cricket World Cup Win for India.
- ❖ 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>: Anna Hazare's Contributions to India

- **This competition is open both for IAM and non-IAM members.**
- **There is NO entry fee.**
- Every participant must create a doodle that reflects the theme of his or her age group. Doodles that do not reflect the theme of their age group will be immediately disqualified.
- The art will be judged based on creativity, originality, color, and overall feel.
- Each doodle must be drawn on 8.5" x 11" paper.
- Any artist medium can be used. Crayons, color pencils, color pens, water paints etc., are all allowed.
- Artist's full name, age, parent's e-mail address **must** be written clearly on the back of the artwork. Any doodle without this information will also be disqualified.
- **Deadline for emailing in your registration is September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2011.** Registration for kids below the age of 13 years should come from their parent's email ID. This shows parents approval for their child to participate.
- **Registration emails must include** artist's full name, age, grade, parent's email and best contact telephone.
- After registering, your doodle artwork can be dropped off between the dates of September 3<sup>rd</sup> to September 24 at the following locations:
